WHAT'S GOING ON HERE?

The pandemic didn't stop us from craving human connection

• If anything, it intensified that craving!

Vulnerable populations were forced into isolation

• Older adults in particular are being targeted

First the attacker makes a connection

- Social media makes this easy and natural
- Connections in common = (fake) legitimacy
- Impersonation is easy
- Attackers count on us to want to like them!

Create a fabric of trust and communication,

then ask for something

The Grandparent Scam

- A grandparent receives a phone call (or sometimes an email) from their "grandchild"
 - Often late at night / early in the morning (when most people aren't thinking that clearly)
- The fake kid claims to be traveling in a foreign country and has gotten into a bad situation:
 - …arrested for drugs / car accident / mugged
 - …needs money wired ASAP
 - ...doesn't want her parents told
- Sometimes, instead of the "grandchild" making the phone call, the criminal pretends to be an arresting police officer, a lawyer, a doctor at a hospital, etc.
- Sometimes the phony grandkid will talk first and then hand the phone over to an accomplice...to make the fake story more convincing!

Why We Fall For It

- Digital Footprints
 - Name, age, even real-time location of real grandkids
- Scammers Make Good Storytellers
 - Maybe your grandkid isn't the most responsible kid out there
 - Even if she is, could we imagine this happening?
- We Like to Help!

Red Flags

- Unexpected
- Urgent
- Unknown Phone Number / Email

Don't be Fooled!

- Urgency = Red Flag
- Verify "Out of Band"
- Talk it Out





The Invoice Scam


- You receive an "invoice" for goods or services you never ordered
 - The amount is prominently displayed...
 - ...just enough to alarm and anger you
 - ...but not enough to make you think it's a scam
- A helpful phone number is provided "in case you have any questions or concerns"
- The whole point of the scam is to get you to call the listed number!
- Scammers will try to install malware on your system...
 - ...or get your bank account information...
 - ...or both!



- Use of Legitimate Infrastructure
 - You've heard of Intuit / PayPal / DocuSign
- We Hate Getting Ripped Off!

Red Flags

- Reality Check = FAIL
